Don't forget a party at the end of first PIP day


Maintain alignment after the PIP





Quantitive measurements creates questions .. you need have other tools for discovering *what* to do

Only measure where you have decisions that need data

Understand the behavioural effects of measurements

Overall, be careful with metrics ...



Ok, how do we measure flow then?



- Flow Time (lead time)
- Flow Velocity (througput)
- Flow Load (wip)
- Flow Predictability (BV assigned vs done)
- Flow Efficiency (process time vs lead time)

Use them or loose them!

TIP: Always be aware of the cost of the ART/a PI

DO <u>NOT</u> focus on utilization
